

This happy picture of the Queen was made during her 6½-hour visit to the Royal Agricultural Show at Newton Abbot in July 3, 1952. Crowds lined the street to welcome the first British monarch to visit the town since Charles I was there in 1625. Waiting to greet the Queen at the Royal Pavilion was the Minister of Agriculture, Sir Thomas Dugdale. The Queen later presented the Royal Agricultural Society's long-service medal to 14 farm workers whose length of service on one farm ranged from 66 years to 40 years.
